

Easy Christmas Tree



Tree

- 1 2-foot Christmas tree
- 1 50-count strand string lights
- 1 9-foot spool wired ribbon
- 1 wire tie
- 1 tree skirt

Flowers

- 1 to 2 faux flower bushes
- 2 to 3 glitter twig bushes

Bows

1 to 2 packages gift bows

Assemble and arrange branches on Christmas tree. Add lights.

Make a large bow for the topper and attach with the tie. Tie on the tree skirt.



For a flower tree, separate flower stems and glitter twigs from base of bush with a wire cutter. Insert flower stems and glitter twigs between branches where desired.

For a gift bow tree, place bows into tree branches where desired. Make sure the tree branches securely hold the bows.

Note: Amount of flowers, gift bows, and lights will vary based on the size of the tree and size of purchased products. Substitute floral picks in place of separating a floral bush. Using flowers or decorative picks works well for various seasons, including a festive fall tree. For a fall tree, use a combination of leaves and fall flowers.
