

Turkey Bones Centerpiece



- Bones from a 10 to 12 pound turkey
- 1 (6 inch) Styrofoam ball
- 7 (5 3/4 inch) wood craft sticks
- 3 (300 count) bags assorted pom-poms in fall colors
- 2 (3/8 inch) yellow rhinestones
- 2 (3/16 inch) blue rhinestones

Clean and bleach turkey bones. For this project, use 1 upper wing bone for head, beak, and neck; 2 leg bones for the legs; 2 fan shaped lower back bones for the wings; and a wishbone.

Insert head, leg, and wing bones and craft sticks into the Styrofoam ball. Glue bones to ball.

Using hot glue, attach pom-poms of appropriate size to Styrofoam ball, bones, and craft sticks. Glue larger rhinestone to head for eye. Glue smaller rhinestone to center of larger rhinestone to make pupil. Repeat for opposite side of head. Glue wishbone to wing and body of the turkey. Display your creation in a small roaster.

Note: Use smaller pom-poms on beak, wing tips, "toes," and as needed. Use larger pom-poms on the body and tail feathers of the turkey.
